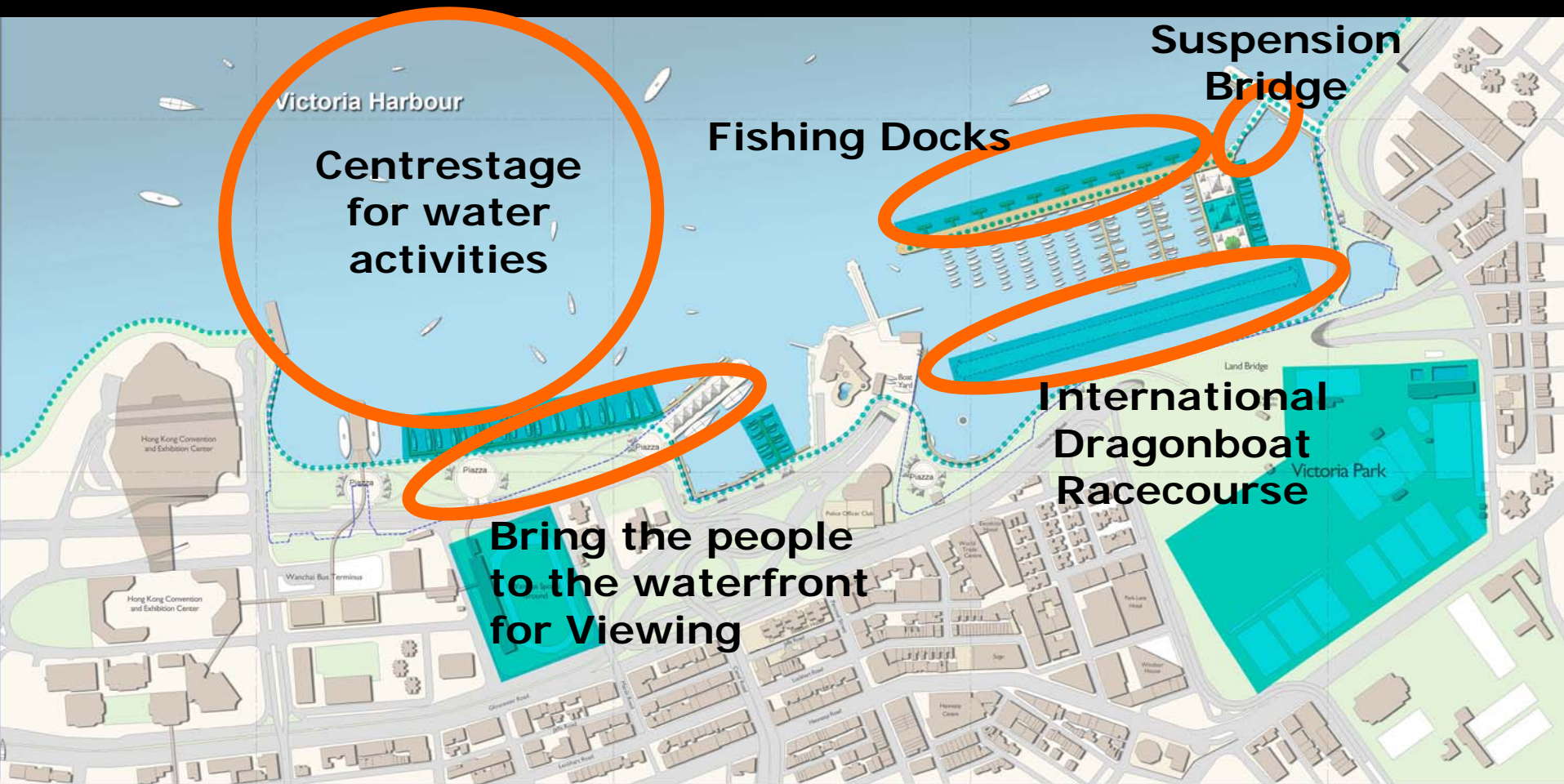

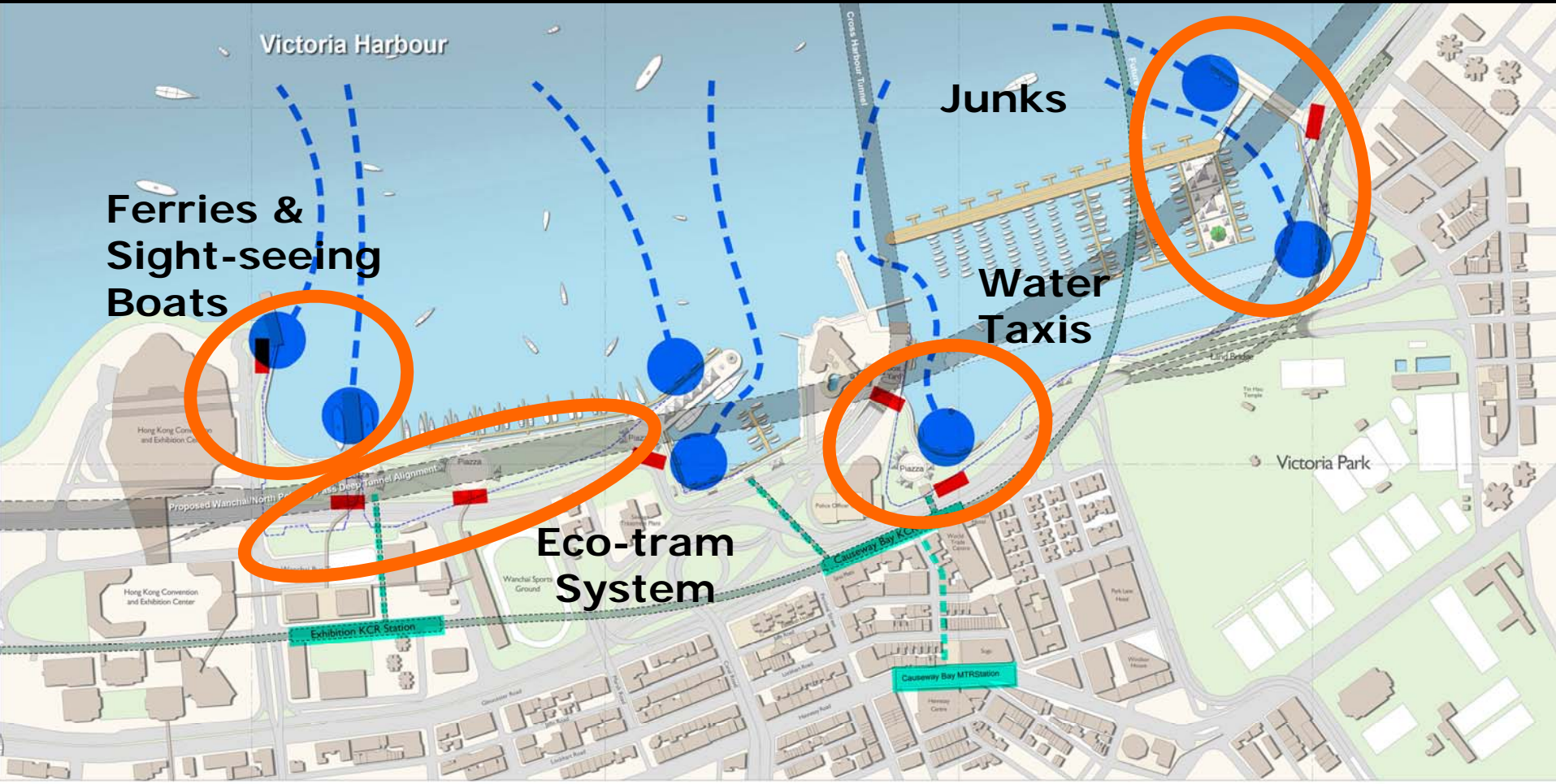

# Cycling and Jogging Tracks to Connect Northern Shore of Hong Kong Island



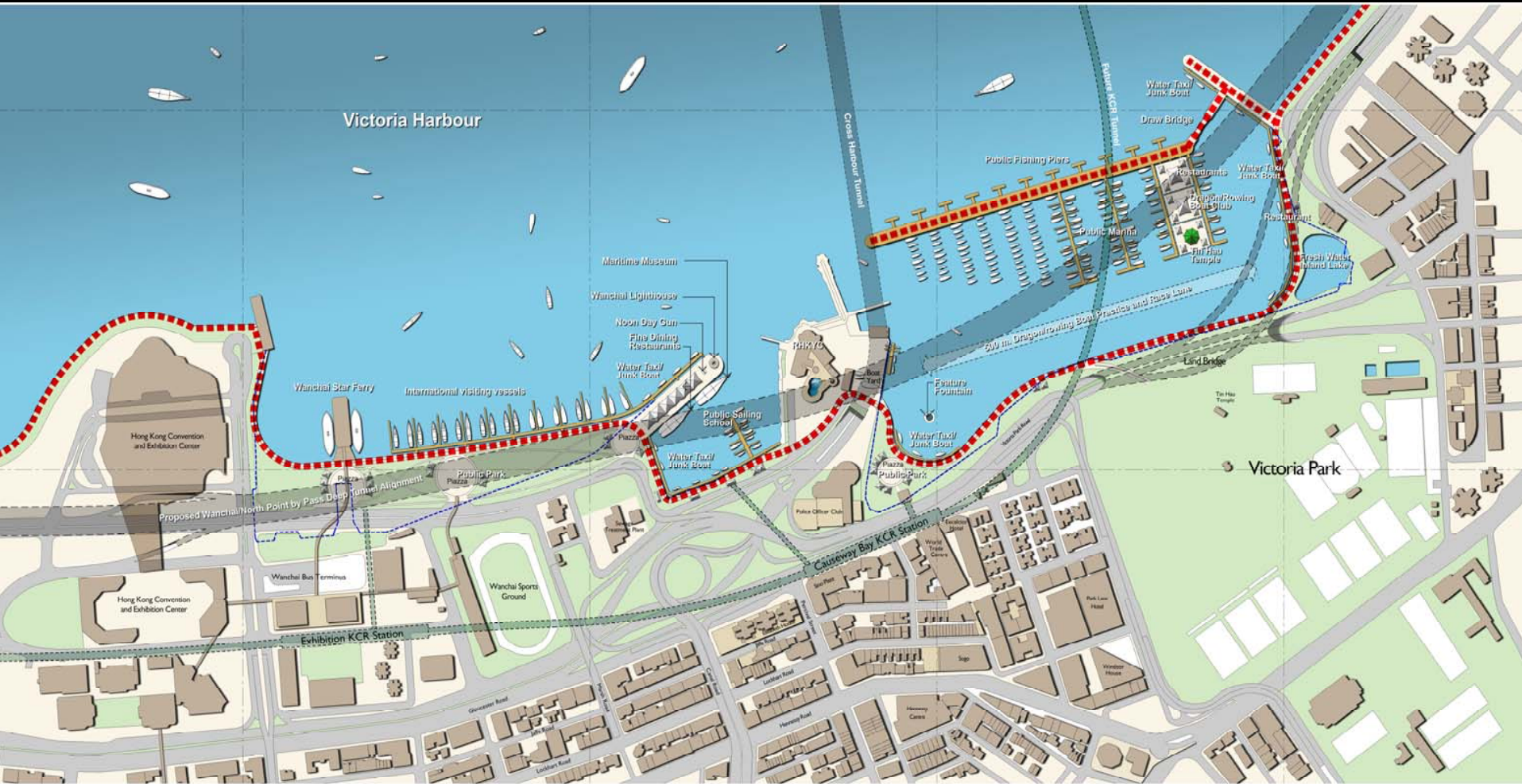
