This month <u>Legco</u> has focused its attention on government plans for Central, City Forum <u>城市論壇</u> focused the public's attention on the same issues, <u>Urban Land Institute</u> started focusing their attention on our harbour developments, and <u>Ming Pao</u> focused their attention on us.

## Past Events

### Central in Legco

Government presented to Legco its Central Plans, shown to HBF in <u>September</u>. Legislators were concerned with the amount of commercial space allowed on the plans. The panel passed a non-binding motion to call for a substantial reduction of the commercial element in the project area, and a ban on the creation of new offices, shopping malls and hotels in the area.

### Oil Street

The rezoning request to scale down and revise plans of site on Oil Street to provide more open space for North Point, by <u>Designing Hong Kong Harbour District</u>, was rejected by the Town Planning Board. The Board has however requested an amendment to the planning brief to take account of changing community aspirations, the board's <u>Vision and Goals for Victoria Harbour</u>, <u>Harbour Planning Principles</u> and <u>Urban Design Guidelines</u>.

### Ming Pao

HBF Chairman Andrew Long was interviewed in Ming Pao on 31st October where he reiterated HBF's key messages of the need for long-term holistic vision, the necessity for a Harbour Agency and the need to reconsider the use of Tamar. Reference was also made to <u>our</u> waterfront case study on Roston
